48	To receive and accept Apologies (LGA 1972 S85 (1)) Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Chapman & Glew for personal reasons.

51	To hear an update on the cricket square and agree any actions required. The clerk reported that RC had identified where the square is and has bought the equipment needed to rope off the cricket square. The square needs to be cut as short as possible and scarified. The ECB surveys will resume once the weather gets better. To discuss the projects and work identified for the sport pavilion with the objective of agreeing a list by priority and timeline and agree any actions required. The decking companies all recommended that football studs are not allowed on the decking. The cllrs discussed the option for the decking and agreed that they would like the oak finish balustrade and decking with the aluminium subframe. The clerk was awaiting updated information for the decarbonisation project. Resolved
