40	To receive and accept Apologies (LGA 1972 S85 (1)) Apologies received and accepted for cllr Latreille	
41	To receive Interests in accordance with the Localism Act 2011 and the Parish Council code of conduct. To receive councillors' declarations of interest regarding matters on the agenda and consider any written requests for dispensation as a result. No interests were declared and there were no requirements for dispensations. Any changes to register of interests should be notified to the clerk.	
43	To consider for approval the draft minutes of 3rd April 2024 and 19th June 2024. Resolved: the draft minutes were approved as a true reflection of the meeting and signed by the chair.	
44	To discuss the grounds maintenance of the Sportsfield. It was noted that the field maintenance is predominantly the responsibility of the football club. The area around the garage is cut by the PC grounds maintenance company, the hedging is cut annually on instruction of the PC. It was agreed that the clerk organise for the hedging to be cut in September/October.	
45	To discuss progress on the cricket square renovation and agree any actions required. The clerk had received notification that the cricket pitch could benefit from spraying the square for total weed killer then scarify x2 ways seed and top dress it would be £1,400 + materials. The cllrs agreed they would want to go ahead and would ask at the next finance meeting for the funds to be delegated.	
46	To give a brief update on the decking and decarbonisation projects. The clerk explained that the decking would be erected the following week and was due to be finished before the weekend hire. Work had begun on the decarbonisation project and should be finished by the end of October.	
47	To receive for approval the user agreement for the forthcoming year. Resolved: The user agreement be adopted.	
48	To discuss the cleaning of the pavilion and agree any actions required. The clerk reported that the cleaner had notified her that the hourly rate would increase to £20. Cllrs accepted the increase.	
49	To agree a date for the next meeting. The next meeting will take place Wednesday 2nd October 2024.
