

Summary of responses to Sedlescombe traffic survey



- 👤 Approximately 50% of households (264) responded to the survey
- 👤 90% of residents are very concerned about speed & volume of traffic through the village
- 👤 93.5% identified HGV's as their major cause for concern
- 👤 86% see the preservation of our iconic Geese and village green as important issues
- 👤 89% listed reduction in the volume of traffic as their first priority
- 👤 88% said that the focus should be on re-routing of HGV's / commercial traffic
- 👤 A large majority (78%) support a voluntary 20 mph speed limit through the village
- 👤 69% would like a permanent reduction of the speed limit though the village
- 👤 A majority also support physical traffic-calming measures, such as
 - 👤 Extending the 30 mph limit up Church hill
 - 👤 Chicanes on the northern approach
 - 👤 Chicanes on the southern approach
- 👤 86% would like the Parish Council to have more direct control over the village roads
